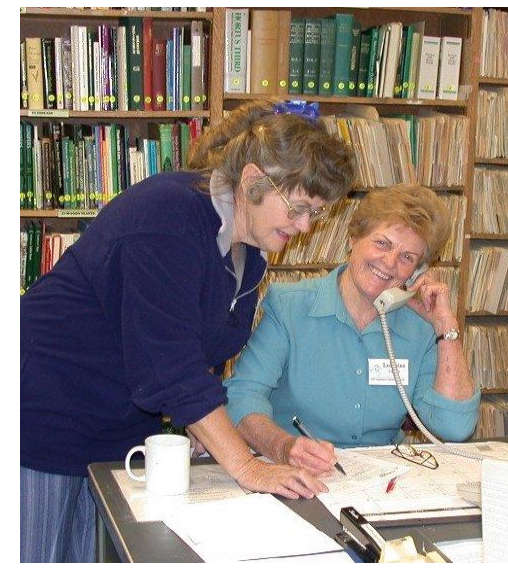

**Apprentices receive approximately 70 hours of training by Colorado State University Extension agents, local and regional specialists, & Advanced Master Gardeners.*

**Training is provided in Botany, Soils, Irrigation, Plant Pathology, Compost, Entomology, Trees & Shrubs, Fruit Growing, Turf Care, Vegetable Gardening, Environmental Issues & Pesticide Safety, Weed Management, Xeriscape, Native Plants, Perennials and more.*

**Classes are every week January through March, from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Additional workshops and volunteer opportunities are offered throughout the year.*

**Training takes place in Grand Junction. Volunteer service takes place at your local county office.*

**Following the training, Apprentice Master Gardeners work a minimum of 50 hours through Extension, assisting clients at our offices. A non-volunteer option is also available, for an additional charge.*



Master Gardeners are trained in horticulture and extend research-based information on gardening to the community, fostering successful gardeners.

Master Gardener 2018 Training Cost

The cost of the program is \$170, which includes the Tri River Area Master Gardener Manual, fact sheets, publications and supporting material. If you are not available to work the volunteer hours you may take the course as a certified gardener for \$530. The course is also offered as an online badge program.



Service Commitment

Following training, Apprentice Master Gardeners return a minimum of 50 hours to Extension. They answer gardening questions at our area offices, research and diagnose plant problems, assist at clinics and workshops, maintain our demonstration gardens, and may participate in other Extension horticulture projects.
