- _____ 5. Each member is expected to exhibit every project taken during the club year. Exhibit may be local (at club meetings). Indicate number members exhibiting at County Fair or other exhibitions

- _____ 6. Each member shall receive instruction in judging and participate in judging products related to projects taken.
- _____ 7. 100% completion: Members must complete a project and leaders should make a final report to the local Extension office (report will be mailed out). If a member completes one project carried, he/she is counted as a completion.
