# SERVSAFE®: SERVING SAFE FOOD

## WHAT IS SERVSAFE®?

ServSafe® is a nationally recognized program developed by the National Restaurant Association, that provides food safety training, exams and educational materials to food service managers.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Food Service Managers who are not certified by an accredited Food Safety Course. The Colorado Retail Food Establishment Rules and Regulations state that “at least one employee with authority to direct and control food preparation and service shall be a food protection manager who has been certified by an accredited program.” Class space is limited. Registration is on a first come first serve basis.

## WHY ATTEND?

ServSafe® participants who score 75% or above on the exam become certified and are qualified to become instructors of food handlers. Participants who score 90% or above become certified and are eligible to become ServSafe® Certification Instructors for their own organization/company. An added bonus is that under the new code this certification may be able to lower your risk assessment score which may result in fewer visits from your County Health Sanitarian.
