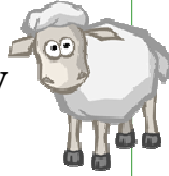
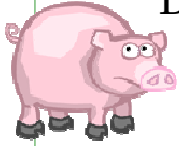

Meat Quality Assurance Trainings



The following is the “Official” State 4-H policy regarding the Meat Quality Assurance Act and the required training:

- Any 4-H member enrolled in a market or breeding livestock project that has not previously attended training **must do so.**
- Any 4-H member who was a Junior (age 13 or under) and is moving into the Senior division in 2019 (age 14 as of December 31, 2018), will be required to attend the training.
- **Everyone** enrolled in a 4-H livestock project must sign the Tri River Area 4-H Commitment to Excellence.

In summary, all 4-H members must attend the Wholesome Meat training once as a Junior (13 and under) and once as a Senior (14 and over). You may attend training in another county if you cannot make the date scheduled in your county. Be sure to sign in when you arrive, this way we have a record of your attendance. Attendance at a MQA Class will fulfill swine members Pork Quality Assurance Training requirements. Below is a list of dates for these trainings:

- April 15 - Meat Quality Assurance Class, 6:30 PM, C Building, Mesa County Fairgrounds
- April 16 - Meat Quality Assurance Class, 6:30 PM, Heritage Hall, Delta County Fairgrounds
- April 17 - Meat Quality Assurance Class, 6:30 PM, Montrose County Fairgrounds
- April 18 - Meat Quality Assurance Class, 6:30 PM, San Miguel County

Important Swine Nomination Information!

This year Delta County 4-H families with market swine project members will be responsible for tagging all swine that they intend to take to the Delta County Fair and/or the Colorado State Fair. Families will check their tags out from their club organizational leader or their swine project leader.

Families will NOT check out tags from the 4-H office. Club organizational leaders and/or swine project leaders need to double check with their swine project members as to how many tags each member needs. The Extension office needs to be emailed with a count for each club by March 29th.

ATTENTION: Delta County 4-H members MUST officially make all project additions and/or deletions on or before May 1, 2019.

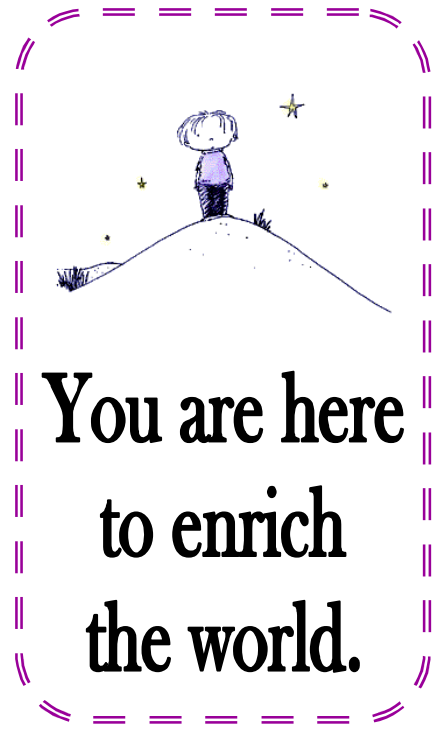
Members who have not dropped projects that they do not want to participate in, and who do not turn in a completed record book, will not be allowed to enroll in that project area the following year. In addition, members who do not enroll in a project by the above date will not be allowed to show in that project at the 2019 Delta County Fair.

2019 Horse Identification & Dog Identification Due Date



The due date for both Horse Identifications and the Dog Identifications is May 1, 2019. All information for these two species must be entered on **4HOnline** by 4:30 PM on the above listed date in order for animals to be shown at the Delta County Fair. *Instructions on how to do this are available in your 4-H Horse and Dog record books.* Please be aware that our summer hours take effect this day and the office closes at 4:30 PM.



RECORD BOOK POLICY



All Delta County 4-H members with general projects (those that are displayed in the exhibit hall) who do NOT bring an exhibit to the 2019 Delta County Fair will be required to turn in their record books in September on the same date that the livestock, horse, dog and shooting sports record books are due! (This date will be published in future newsletters.) The 70% completion requirement will apply to these books. In addition, general project members who do not participate in the 2019 Fair and fail to turn in their record book(s) will not be allowed to participate in those project(s) the following 4-H year.

FIRST YEAR LEADER BACKGROUND CHECKS



All first year leaders will be submitted for a background check. (Consent for this is given when you fill out and sign your Volunteer Leader enrollment.) After you have enrolled online you will receive an email requesting that you go to a secure website called HireRight, which is approved by CSU, and provide requested information. Background checks cannot be completed without your information. Your enrollment will remain pending until your background check is complete. Please note that if you do not complete this information you will not be allowed to participate in the 4-H program as a leader. (All information remains confidential—even the county offices are not provided with details.) If you have any questions regarding first year leader background checks, please call Jackie at 874-2198.

STATE FAIR RULE FOR GENERAL PROJECTS!

If a member enrolls in two **units** of the same project (For example: leathercraft. A member enrolls in Unit 2 & Unit 3) they must exhibit in the higher unit. When a member takes two units at the same time, they should master the skills of the lower unit and therefore exhibit in the higher unit.

Enrollment Fees

The 2018/2019 fee for **regular 4-H members** (8-18 years of age) will be **\$50.00** for the first two projects and \$5.00 for each additional project beyond the first two. **Cloverbud** (ages 5-7) fees will be **\$30.00**. (All ages are based on December 31st, 2018.)

Returning members must have re-enrolled by close of business on February 1, 2019. Members re-enrolling after this deadline will be assessed a **\$10 per member** late fee. All members must be enrolled by close of business on May 1st of 2018 in order to participate at the County Fair. (Late fees do not apply to Cloverbud, new member, and leader enrollments.)

SHOOTING SPORTS LEADER TRAINING

2019 Shooting Sports Leader Training Workshops are being offered to 4-H Leaders and Teen Leaders in Garfield County March 29-31, 2019. There must be at least 25 registered leaders at a training site in order for the workshop to be held.

The training will begin at 6:00 PM on Friday, March 29th and conclude at Noon on Sunday, March 31, 2019. Participants **MUST** attend the entire training to receive certification.

Cost is \$135 for adults and teens (ages 14-19). **Registration** is offered through 4-HOnline and opens February 15th. **Deadline is Friday, March 15th - NO EXCEPTIONS!** (Important: only active, approved and enrolled 4-H leaders may attend these workshops.) Fee includes lunch and dinner on Saturday.

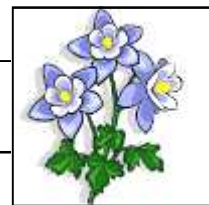
