



Paper Plate Spider Webs

What you need:

- Paper plate
- Paper spider
- Yarn
- Tape

Instructions:



1. Take your paper plate. Notice that the center has already been cut out and holes have been punched around the edge. If you want to decorate or color your plate, do so now.



2. Feed one end of yarn through one of the holes. Use tape to secure it in place to the back of the plate.



3. Use the other end of the yarn and thread through all of the holes on your plate. Thread the yard going across the plate to make it look like the spider web. When you are finished threading, you can use tape to secure the yarn to the back of the tape.

4. Tape your spider to its new web!



Spiders and their webs:

Spider webs are built from silk. Spiders produce silk within their bodies and use their back legs to pull it out of two openings called spinnerets. Spiders use webs for many purposes, most importantly to trap insects for food. Webs and spider silk also help spiders protect their homes, eggs sacs, and are useful for travel.
